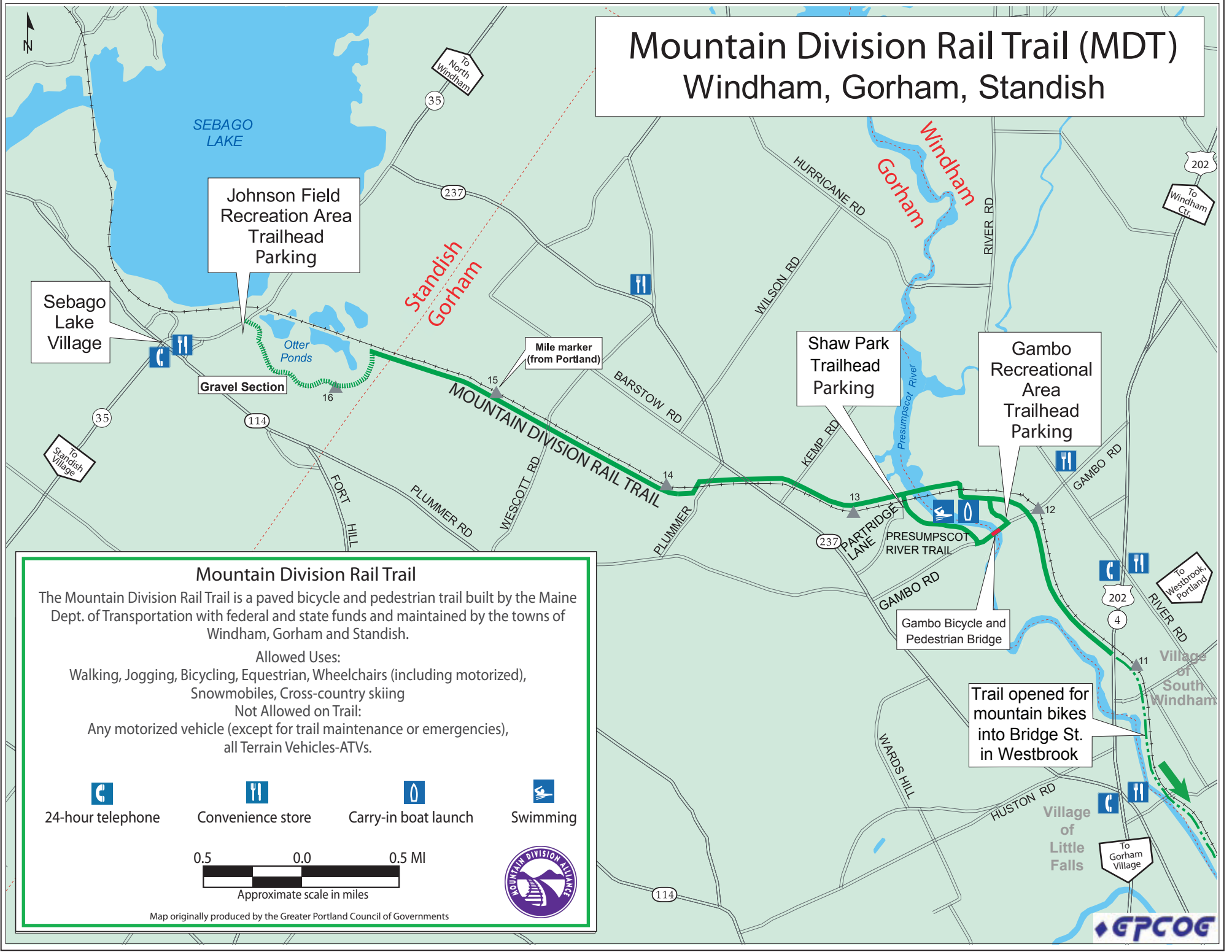


Mountain Division Rail Trail (MDT) Windham, Gorham, Standish

The Mountain Division Rail Trail is a paved bicycle and pedestrian trail built by the Maine Dept. of Transportation with federal and state funds and maintained by the towns of Windham, Gorham and Standish.

Allowed Uses:

Walking, Jogging, Bicycling, Equestrian, Wheelchairs (including motorized),
Snowmobiles, Cross-country skiing

Not Allowed on Trail:

Any motorized vehicle (except for trail maintenance or emergencies),
all Terrain Vehicles-ATVs.

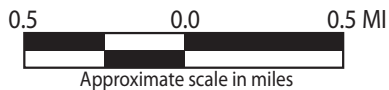
