1. News/updates

Ben's last day as Planning Director is April 6. Hoping to make arrangements to continue this work on an interim basis until a new Planning Director is brought on board.

2. Ordinances

- a. Zoning Map updates relative to Future Land Use Map
 - i. Goal – better differentiate Growth Areas and Rural Areas
 - ii. Task – Look at the map, what's in, what's out
 - iii. Critical changes?

Amanda will be using the work the LRPC has already done to draft up some working maps (internal use only) that the LRPC can refer to over the coming weeks with a focus on the work above. The group liked the approach of focusing first on the mapping and ordinance changes for Rural Areas, then mapping and ordinance changes for Growth Areas. The work will be incremental in that order, but no changes are expected to be sent to the Council for formal review until a complete package of changes is put together.
