

TOWN OF WINDHAM NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed Bids addressed to the Municipality of Windham and endorsed on the wrapper “Bids for WIN 22166.00, Route 35 Sidewalk Improvements in the Municipality of Windham” will be received from contractors at the Windham Town Office, 8 School Road, Windham, ME 04062 until 3:00 o’clock PM (prevailing time) on June 10, 2020 and at that time and place opened and read via Zoom. The link to the opening will be available on the Town of Windham website 1 week before the opening and will be emailed to those that have submitted bids. Bids will be accepted from all bidders.

The lowest responsive bidder must demonstrate successful completion of projects of similar size and scope to be considered for the award of this contract.

Description: Federal Aid Project No. 2216600, WIN 22166.00

Location: In Cumberland County, project is located along Route 35 (Tandberg Trail) in Windham from Route 302 (Roosevelt Trail) and extending 0.36 miles to Basin Road.

Outline of Work: This project includes the construction of a 5 foot wide sidewalk and esplanade along the northern side of Route 35. Crosswalk improvements are proposed at the intersection of Route 35 and Route 302. Also, a mid-block crossing with Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons is proposed to provide access from the proposed sidewalk to Northwood Drive and other incidental work.

The basis of award will be Section 0001, Base Bid Only.

Each Bid must be made upon blank forms provided by the Municipality and must be accompanied either by a bid bond at 5% of the bid amount or an official bank check, cashier’s check, certified check, certificate of deposit, or United States postal money order in the amount of \$15,000 payable to Municipality of Windham as a Bid Guaranty. A Contract Performance Surety Bond and a Contract Payment Surety Bond, each for 100% of the Contract price, will be required of the successful Bidder.

This Contract is subject to all applicable Federal Laws, as well as the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise program requirements as set forth by the Maine Department of Transportation.

All work shall be governed by the Maine Department of Transportation’s Standard Specifications (March 2020 Edition) and Standard Details (March 2020 Edition).
