LATE NIGHT HOURS

The Windham Town Clerk's office will be OPEN LATE on Wednesday, Oct.28, & Thursday, Oct. 29 until 6:00 p.m. & Friday, Oct. 30, 2020 until 7:00 p.m. to allow people to do the following:

- ★ Register to vote (*please bring I.D. and proof of residency*)
- ★ Change your name or address
- ★ Vote by Absentee

We are encouraging Absentee voting to minimize interaction with others during this public health pandemic.

If you go to the polls, we're asking you to PLEASE WEAR A MASK and expect extended wait times due to the small number of people who will be allowed in the gym and waiting in line in the hallways.

If your address or name has changed, you must update it before voting. You may do it early in the Clerk's Office or at the Registrar's table on Election Day before you vote.

All Absentee Ballots must be returned to the Town Clerk's Office by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day or before, and please do not bring them to the High School.

The Registrar of Voters is available Monday – Friday, 8:00-4:00 in the Clerk's Office and on Election Day at the Polls. Please bring an I.D. and proof of Windham residency.

Absentee Ballot Processing will begin on Tuesday, October 27 – October 31 at Town Hall from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and at the Polls on Election Day at 7:00 am and every hour on the hour until 8:00 p.m. or until finished.
